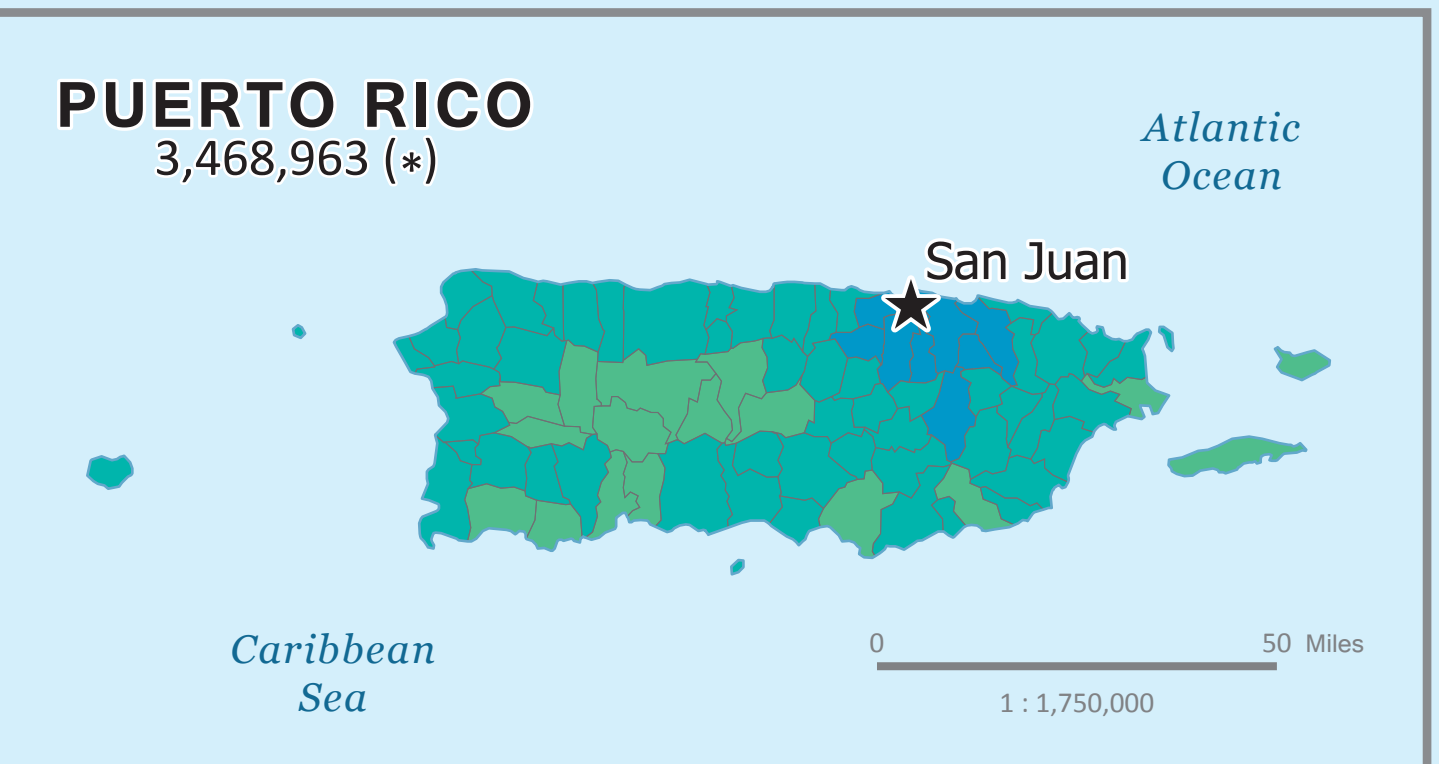

Highest and Lowest Median Incomes

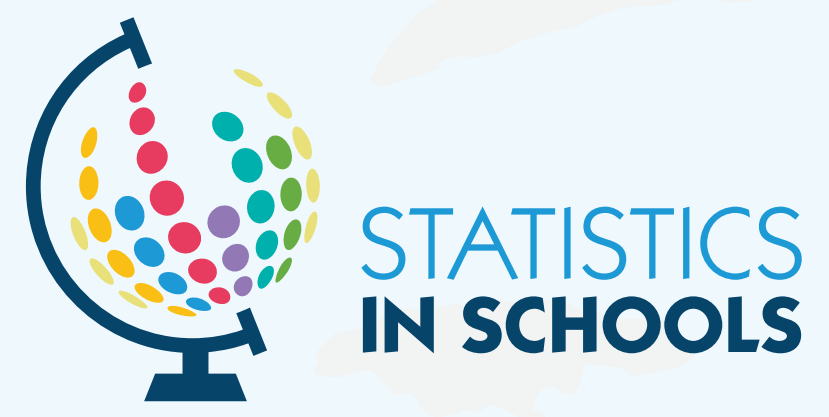
